



Presentations

Geneviève Savard, École Nouvelle Frontière Community school coordinator (CSC), was invited to make a presentation about the role of the CSC and an account of her activities in the school. The Chair, Mrs. Sylvianne Maisonneuve thanked Mrs. Savard for her presentation and commitment.

Maryse Simon and Geneviève Savard, members of the FPPA Board of Directors (*Fédération des parents francophones de l'Alberta*) were present to share the FPPA's objectives, programs and services. They also indicated that the FPPA would like to work more closely with the School Board. Following discussions, Mrs. Maisonneuve thanked the FPPA members for taking the time to connect with the CSNO Board of Trustees.

2018-2019 Budget

The CSNO adopted the 2018-2019 budget with revenues of \$10,278,689 and expenditures of \$10,338,783, and an anticipated deficit of \$60,094.

2018-2019 School Fees

School fees for 2018-2019 were approved for each school. The School fees are submitted to the Minister's office for approval and will be posted on the Web site as soon as they are approved.

Infrastructure - ÉQV

On May 14, the Director of Infrastructure - North Region visited École des Quatre-Vents (ÉQV) and École Héritage to ascertain the challenges of these two buildings.

In regards to advancing the ÉQV modernization project, the School Board will contact the Minister of Education to request a meeting and to consider the federal funding available for Francophone infrastructure projects.

Further, the CSNO will take steps to communicate with the school community, the municipalities and local organizations to raise awareness about the ÉQV modernization project and to identify potential partners.

LDC: Leadership AAA

The Board adopted changes to the locally developed course: "Leadership AAA", following recommendations from the Ministry of Education. The administration, in collaboration with FJA, revised the "Leadership AAA 15, 25, 35" courses. It was decided to eliminate the "Leadership AAA 35" course and to combine the three courses in two, to offer Leadership 15 (5 credits) and Leadership 25 (5 credits).

2018 CSNO Bursary

The 2018 CSNO Scholarship will be awarded at the graduation celebration in June.

School Transportation Survey

Administration Report

GARDERIE *les petits boucs* DAYCARE

The steps to open "*les petits boucs*" daycare at École Nouvelle Frontière are progressing well. The licence will be granted when the renovations of the space are completed. As a result, the School Board cannot open daycare registrations until the licence is granted, but parents can put their names on a waiting list by contacting the school.

Class Improvement Fund (CIF)

The Classroom Improvement Fund will be renewed for 2018-2019 with new criteria. The focus of next year's CIF will be on addressing the classroom experience by hiring teachers and support staff. For the current year, the CIF was allocated to classroom projects and professional development.



High School Retention Survey

The FCSFA high school retention survey is underway for the four Francophone school boards. For the CSNO, the study involves the École Nouvelle Frontière school community. Grades 7-12 parents and students, teachers, principals, and parents of students who have left the School Board have been surveyed.

A report of the study will be submitted in June.

School Nutrition Project

Funding for the School Nutrition Project will continue in the 2018-2019 school year. The program will be maintained at École Nouvelle Frontière with a free lunch served daily. Administration and principals will decide on new projects for 2018-2019.

HOOR-ZERO

Implementation of the Hour Zero School Emergency Program is underway. A new emergency response plan is in place for École Nouvelle Frontière and training was held with École Nouvelle Frontière staff on May 2nd.

The emergency response plans for École Héritage and École des Quatre-Vents will be implemented in September 2018.
