2018-2019 Enrolment

As of September 30, 420 students (K to 12) were enrolled in the CSNO schools. In addition, 55 children were enrolled in the preschool programs.

Accountability Pillar October 2018

The CSNO's October 2018 Accountability Pillar Overall Summary results are very good. The CSNO achieved **"Very High" and "High" standards in 13 of the 16** measures, including:

- ❖ Safe and Caring Schools
- ❖ Education Quality
- ❖ Drop Out Rate
- ❖ High School Completion Rate (3 yr)
- ❖ PAT: Acceptable
- ❖ PAT: Excellence
- ❖ Diploma Exam Participation Rate (4+ Exams)
- ❖ Transition Rate (6 yr)
- ❖ Work Preparation
- ❖ Citizenship
- ❖ Parent Involvement
- ❖ School Improvement

In addition, the CSNO reached or exceeded the provincial average in 10 areas. Notably, the PAT:Acceptable results were above the provincial average (CSNO 88% compared to Prov. 74%).

2018 SURVEY – French language and culture in our schools

As a francophone School Board, the CSNO has the mandate to provide quality French-language education and, in addition, to enhance francophone culture and develop a sense of belonging to the francophone community.

In order to assess the satisfaction of the school community regarding its specific goal related to French language and culture, the CSNO administered "French Language and francophone culture in our schools" survey to all parents, teaching staff and students (grades 4 to 12) in June 2018. This survey is complementary to the Accountability Pillar survey.

The survey results were generally very positive. Some highlights of the survey include:

- 93% of parents and teachers and 82% of students who responded to the survey are satisfied/very satisfied that **"the practices and decisions of the school reflect the values, culture and identity of the francophone minority community."**
- 92% of respondents are satisfied/very satisfied that **"the school values the French language ensuring its use and its quality in all its activities."**
- 92% of teachers and parents and 83% of students are satisfied/very satisfied that **"the school creates an environment where students can develop their francophone identity."**
- 87% of parents and 80 % of students and teachers are satisfied/very satisfied that **"the school provides the development of the sense of belonging of the student to the francophone community."**
- 73% of respondents are satisfied that **"the school communicates to students and parents the importance of using French as the language of communication at school and at home."**
- 73% of respondents are satisfied/very satisfied that **"the Francophone School is present and visible in the community."**

The results of the survey, as well as the comments, will help the CSNO to improve the strategies used to achieve this goal. The CSNO wishes to thank all those who participated in the survey.
