In May, the CSNO created an advisory committee to support the CSNO administration during the implementation of the project. Currently, the project is still in the consultation phase.

New School for Kindergarten to Grade 12:

- Area: 2,881 m2
- Core Capacity: 220 (Kindergarten to 12) + 20 (Preschool)
- Build-out Capacity with modulars 320 (K to 12) + 20 (Preschool)

Evolution of the new school design

- The CSNO invested \$400,000 to ensure that the preschool was integrated in the initial planning. In addition, the CSNO received financial support from the ACFA of Rivière-la-Paix (\$45,000) towards this part of the project.
- STANTEC is proposing versions of the design that evolve according to consultations and project limitations.
- Revision of the plan continues...
- The final plan will be approved by Alberta Infrastructure.
