



Presentation

The School Board welcomed École Heritage School Council members, Chair Christine Aubin and Principal Nicole Walisser. Highlights of the School Council accomplishments include the successful 2020 graduation celebration, the sustained participation in the virtual AGM, as well as School Council meetings, and the school's and School Board's excellent COVID-19 response. Also noted was the challenge that parents were faced with regarding the significant technological shift during students at-home learning.

The Catholic aspect at École Héritage is always a priority, and several activities are implemented to emphasize it throughout the year.

The School Board continues its discussions regarding the need for École Héritage to have the support of a francophone parish. The School Board thanked the members of the School Council for their continued commitment. The School Board confirmed that the modernization of École Heritage building is the number one priority of the CSNO's Capital Plan. Important repair work is ongoing and more will take place in the summer.

2020-2024 Education Plan
