2022-2023 Education Plan

The Board approved the “2022-2023” Education Plan Revision, based on the 2020-2024 Education Plan. The 2022-2023 Revision maintains the same main target areas and goals, while the strategies have been revised or added. The plan's success criteria will be assessed based on the results of Alberta Education surveys, as well as the school community surveys and consultations conducted by the Board during the year.

Budget 2022-2023

The Board approved the 2022-2023 budget with an anticipated deficit of \$667,357, based on revenues of \$ 10,793,701 and expenditures of \$ 11,461,059. This budget will make it possible to maintain student programs and services according to the education plan. The deficit is mainly due to the increased costs of classroom and maintenance expenses.
