



RELOCATION PLAN for ÉCOLE DES QUATRE-VENTS (EQV)

The School Board approved a relocation plan, along with a modification to the École des Quatre-Vents (EQV) school calendar that ensure a transition with the least possible impact on teaching and students from kindergarten to grade 12.

SCHOOL CALENDAR:

Teaching days have been reduced from 179 to 177 in order to add two professional development days on October 10th and 11th while meeting the required teaching hours set by the Ministry of Education.

RELOCATION (K to 12):

Conditional upon final inspections (fire, AHS, and infrastructure), the following plan will be implemented.

- October 6th to 9th: Equipment moving from the old to the new school.
- October 10th and 11th: Staff setup in the new school.
- October 12th: Students' welcome to the new school!

DAYCARE AND PRESCHOOL:

The move for the "Les Petits Cœurs" early childhood center will take place as soon as the change of address in the program license is approved by the Ministry of Children's Services.

We hope to receive a quick response, but the moving date cannot be determined at this stage. **Therefore, daycare and pre-kindergarten programs will continue in the current building until further notice.**

LOCALLY APPROVED COURSES

Catholic school trustees approved the use of Religious Studies 15-25-35 within CSNO

(École Héritage) for the school years 2023-2024 to 2026-2027.

FRIENDS OF EDUCATION AWARD

The CSNO awarded the "FRIENDS OF EDUCATION AWARD - ASBA ZONE 1" to Vic's Car Care in Falher. This award recognizes organizations committed to improving student education in our zone. The School Board thanked and congratulated Vic's Car Care for its leadership and positive impact on our school communities at a banquet on September 20th in Peace River. NON-OFFICIAL REGISTRATIONS:

The number of registrations has increased from kindergarten to grade 12; however, there is a decrease at the preschool level. Overall, there are 455 students in K to 12 (compared to 433 in 2022). There are 25 in preschool (compared to 61 in 2022), but there are 23 children in our daycare programs.

The CSNO's survey results remain above the provincial average for several measures. However, the results for the measure "Access to services and support" have declined over the past 2 years. A thorough analysis is underway, and avenues will be explored for the annual education results report.
