New curriculum

Mrs. Sylvette Fillion, CSNO pedagogical advisor, presented an update on the available resources for the implementation of the new curriculum to the Trustees.

Recruitment for the Superintendent position

The Board approved the hiring of an external consultant to assist the trustees in the recruitment process for a new Superintendent of Schools. The job posting will be published in the coming weeks.

School Council Annual Report

In accordance with Administrative Directive 110, the Board received the annual reports from the school councils.

The CSNO school councils have also been invited to the annual school council meeting, scheduled for January 24, 2024. The schedule and details of this meeting are in development.

Superintendent's Report

Education Advisory Committee: Congratulations to Mrs. Sarah Nickonchuk, École des Quatre-Vents principal, who was selected by the Legislative Assembly Office to serve on the Education Advisory Committee. This committee provides ongoing non-partisan feedback, recommendations and support for the Legislative Assembly Office's educational programming, including reviewing current offerings, developing new education programming, and assisting with communication initiatives within the educational community.

Agreement with the Institut Guy Lacombe de la Famille (IGLF) in Grande Prairie: The CSNO is pleased to support IGLF in developing programs to meet the needs of Francophone families in Grande Prairie. This partnership will have a lasting, positive impact on the École Nouvelle Frontière school community.



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Agreement with FJA: The CSNO will provide \$75 for each CSNO student participating in the 2025 Alberta Francophone Games (JFA) to help cover part of the registration fees. Registration fees are \$175 from December 2 to February 14 and then \$200 from February 15 to March 3.
